ADMISSION INTO P.G. COURSES 2022-23 NETAJI SUBHASH CHANDRA BOSE (GOVT. LEAD) COLLEGE, SAMBALPUR – 768005 (ODISHA)

GENERAL RULES FOR ADMISSION:

A. Application Form:

Application form for the P.G. Courses can be downloaded from the College website i.e., www.nscbcollegesbp.org

B. Submission of completed application forms:

The completed application form can be submitted in person with all self-attested Xeroxed document between 10:30 am and 4:30 pm in the **College office** between **18.10.2022 and 31.10.2022** on all working days. Outstation applicants may send the application form through speed post accompanied by self-addressed post card to The Principal, N.S.C.B. (Govt. Lead) College, Sambalpur.

- C. The last date of receipt of application form is 31.10.2022 (5:00 pm).
- **D.** The application form should be duly filled in by the candidate in his/ her own handwriting.

E. Eligibility and Principles of Selection:

Selection will be done strictly as per the CPET- 2022 state wide merit list in the concerned subject.

F. Admission for Reservation:

Scheduled Caste [SC] & Scheduled Tribe [ST]

a) SC-16.25% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for SC applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.:01/06/2015]

- b) ST-22.5% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for ST applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.:01/06/2015]
- c) The reserved seats are not interchangeable between SC & ST.
- d) SC/ST applicants selected for admission on their merit shall not be counted against reserved seats.
- e) However, any modification made by the Government in the reservation policy will be followed during admission.

Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

5% of sanctioned seats shall be reserved for PwD students with extent of disability not below 40% (Blind and Low Vision, Hard of Hearing, Locomotors Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims and Muscular Dystrophy, Autism, Intellectual Disability, Specific Learning Disability and Mental Illness). [G.O. 10161/HE, Dtd.: 07/04/2018].

Ex-Serviceman [ESM], Serving Defence Personnel [SDP], Children of Martyrs [CoM]

1% of the sanctioned seats shall be reserved for Self/Children/ Wife/ Husband/ of ExServiceman, Serving Defence Personnel and Children of Martyrs. [G.O. 10161/HE, Dtd.:07/04/2018]

G. Weightage:

Number of seats in each stream, filled up by the applicants with weightage (which has been mentioned hereunder for various categories of extra-academic achievements), shall not exceed 10% of the sanctioned strength. This 10% of seats shall be proportionately distributed among all categories of applicants. An applicant, who is selected with weightage and taken admission, shall continue to remain in this 10% bracket, even if cut-off mark is reduced in subsequent selections. Maximum 10% weightage mark shall be provided to an applicant.

NCC

Applicants holding B Certificate shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3) or Equivalent examination.

Applicants who have represented the State at the All-India level NCC Camps/ Courses / Activities shall be given weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3) or Equivalent examination.

NSS

Applicants who have represented the Country at International level shall be given first priority during preparation of rank.

Applicants who have represented the state at National Level Camp shall be given Weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree / Equivalent examination.

Applicants who have represented the inter State Category Camp shall be given Weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree/Equivalent examination.

Applicants who have got the best NSS Volunteer award at university level shall be given Weightage of additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured in Degree/Equivalent examination.

Rover & Ranger

Rovers & Rangers possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the President of India shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3)/Equivalent examination.

Rovers & Rangers possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the Governor/ PATRON/ President of the State association shall be given weightage of additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3)/Equivalent examination.

Sports & Games

Applicants who have represented the country at international level shall be given first priority during preparation of rank.

Applicants who have represented the state at national level shall be given weightage of additional 10% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3)/Equivalent examination.

Applicants who have represented the school at the Inter-State School Sports Meet level shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3)/Equivalent examination.

Applicants who have represented their University at Inter University Sports meets shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Degree (+3) /Equivalent examination.

N.B: There will be no validity limit for NCC/ NSS/ Scouts/ Sports certificates.

- 1. CPET State-wide Provisional Merit List Card with Hall Ticket.
- 2. Self-Attested copies of Marksheets and Certificates from Matriculation to Graduation.

- 3. Self-Attested copies of Caste certificates/ PH/ ESM/ Children of Defence Personnel from competent authority.
- 4. Self- Attested copies of certificates of weightage (NCC/ NSS/ ROVER & RANGERS/ SPORTS & GAMES)
- 4. Three Recent Passport size colour photographs.

N.B.: All certificates in original are to be submitted for verification at the time of admission along with College Leaving Certificate. List of the selected candidates will be published in college website.
